**Membership** You are expected to join Scot SAC and Midlothian Sub-Aqua Club soon after the Try Dive. Until both memberships are complete you will not be insured to commence training. If you send off your membership immediately there is every chance it will be through before the next pool session.

## **Medical Forms**

When applying to Scot SAC, you must also complete a UK Sport Diver Medical Form this should be sent with your application form to join. This is simply to say you are fit to dive and is a self-assessment form.

To join **Midlothian Sub-Aqua Club**, firstly the ScotSAC membership plus your self-assessment forms must be approved by ScotSAC. Subscriptions to cover pool rental, air fills, equipment servicing and purchase. Currently we need to ask for small monthly subscription this must be paid by Standing Order/Direct Debit paid to Midlothian Sub Aqua Club. This money is used to fund the hire of the pool and also goes towards the servicing and purchasing of equipment for use by club members.

**Training cannot commence until both memberships are complete.**

## **Equipment**

There is club equipment to use, free of charge throughout your pool training, and on commencement of open water training.

But.... You will be expected to start buying basic equipment as soon after you join i.e. mask, snorkel and fins. Ask an instructor for advice before purchasing, it could save you a lot of money.

Come the end of training, members should be purchasing their own equipment to release club equipment for new trainees.
